On behalf of the Trustees and as the Chair of Littlemore, I present to you the 2023/24 Annual Report and Financial Statements for Littlemore Trust.

Last year, as communities began to recover from extreme weather events, many vulnerable whānau were pushed into even greater hardship. Now, with soaring living costs and economic pressures, the demand for our service is surging. Whānau are facing heart-wrenching choices - having to choose between power, food, petrol, or clothing for their pēpi, as they struggle to afford the necessities of daily life.

With many of our partner organisations overwhelmed by the growing needs of vulnerable whānau, Littlemore is also hearing directly from individual Māmā and whānau in crisis. The need has never been more urgent. In response, we've taken swift action, focusing on practical support for the most deprived households while ensuring that every whānau in need, through our trusted supporting agencies, gets the help they deserve.

I am immensely proud of the Littlemore team, for their dedication to upholding the principles of Te Tiriti o Waitangi at the heart of our work. By embracing tikanga Māori, we build meaningful connections with those we serve.

I give special thanks to our volunteer powered team, for their relentless commitment and hard work behind the scenes. Your efforts do not go unnoticed. To our incredible community of donors, funders, partners, and supporters—thank you. The economic impact of the cost of living crisis continues to bring significant challenges. As we navigate this period of disruption and change, the need in our community remains high.


